What should I already know?

- How old I am.
- That my parents and grandparents are **older** than me.
- I may have **siblings** that are **younger** than me.

Procedural Knowledge

- Create a timeline showing key family events, and then use words such as **before, after, past, present, then** and **now** to describe their **chronology**.
- Describe what life was like when your parents/carers were little and what the **similarities** and **differences** are.
- Describe what life was like when your grandparents were little and what the **similarities** and **differences** are.
- Describe how food have changed over the last **century** - bring in pictures/ interview evidence to show what your parents/carers and grand- parents ate
- Interview your parents/carers and grandparents and ask them what they ate and what they could not eat.
- Research some things that happened **before** your parents/ carers were born and place these on your timeline.
- Research some things that happened **before** your grandparents were born and place these on your timeline.

What will I find out by the end of the unit?

- People that are **older** than me, were born **before** me.
- People that are **younger** than me, were born **after** me.
- Times were **slightly** different when my parents/carers were little.
- Times were very different when my grandparents were little.
- There was a time before my grandparents were born. Life was very different then. People ate different food as some food was not available.
- After WW2 some food was rationed
