

Physical Development

Children will be:

- Developing their small motor skills so that they can use a range of tools competently, safely and confidently.
- Developing their overall body strength, co-ordination, balance and agility during welly Wednesdays and PE sessions
- Progress towards a more fluent style of moving, with developing control and grace.

Maths

Children will learn how to -

- Build numbers beyond 10
- Adding and taking away
- Doubling, sharing and grouping
- Even and odd numbers
- Deepening understanding of patterns
- Counting patterns beyond 10

Understanding the world

Children will:

1. Children follow a teacher drawn map to get to the local pond
2. To be able to locate features on a map. Children place pictures from the walk into correct place on a large scale map.
3. Children to draw their own map of the journey to the pond.

Literacy

- Read simple sentences independently using phonic knowledge and knowledge of tricky words
- Form lower-case and capital letters correctly.
- Write a simple sentence using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces, spelling words in a phonetically plausible way
- Spell words by identifying the sounds and then writing the sound with letter/s.
